2010-2011 Fall/Winter Ice Schedule

Dear Skater,

Our Fall/Winter Ice Season for 2010-2011 will begin on Thursday, September 9, 2010 and end on Friday, April 8, 2011. Please note that our ice rates have gone up due to increases in ice fees at Lynch Arena.

The following **requirements** must be met to skate on our club sessions:

Open Combined: All levels MIF/Freestyle/Dance – **No Pairs** (This exclusion does not apply to similar pairs / duets or dance.) Please consult with your professional before signing up for club sessions.

There will be **NO CLUB ICE** on the following dates:

September 10, 2010 – Providence Open
October 8, 2010 – ONLY 6:10 – 7:00 session is cancelled
November 25, 2010 - Thanksgiving Day
December 3, 2010- PPFSC Holiday Exhibition
December 24, 2010- Christmas Eve
December 31, 2010 – New Year's Eve
January 14-16, 2010 - John W. Kennedy Tournament
February 18-20, 2010 - R.I. Blues Tournament
March 18, 2010 – Basic Skills Show dress rehearsal

APPLICATION DEADLINE – Postmarked by September 1, 2010

There will be a \$10.00 late fee for applications postmarked after September 1, 2010

There will be a \$20 fee added to your bill for each check that is returned to us for insufficient funds. Skaters are placed on sessions in the order in which the assistant treasurer receives the applications up until the deadline. Full members are given first consideration, associates next, then non-members. After the deadline only the post mark is the deciding factor. You may not drop a session once it has begun. The Board of Governors reserves the right to change the level requirements or discipline of any session that is under enrolled. Please check our bulletin board and website for updates and changes.

All **summer ice bills must be paid in full** before the fall/winter application will be accepted. A deposit of **\$100** must accompany application before it will be accepted. We are looking forward to an enjoyable, productive year ahead.

Service Requirement

The Board has established the requirement that each skater who contracts ice time or purchases a Season Pass work four hours at one of the Club's fundraising activities, such as the Providence Open. The proceeds from fundraisers such as this are being used to subsidize the ice bills of PPFSC skaters, and we need workers to ensure that we are indeed able to successfully run these activities. There will be a variety of options that will be available for service time, assuring that everyone will be able to meet the obligation without difficulty.

Some of the events/activities that will provide service opportunities include:

- the Providence Open in September;
- the Basic Skills Program on Saturdays;
- the Club's Holiday Exhibition in December; and
- the Miele Synchro Open in March.

The service time can be fulfilled by either an adult family member or the skater of an appropriate age. A fee of \$100 will be added to the January ice bill of every skater who does not fulfill the requirement.

The Season Pass

We are offering this option to skaters who are unable to make a commitment to contracted ice time, but purchase many walk-ons over the course of the season. The Season Pass involves the purchase of a package of 20 walk-on passes for the upcoming season. This will cost less than the equivalent number of walk-ons at the regular rate. The advantage of the Season Pass is that it allows flexibility over the course of the season.

The Season Pass

- will be treated like a contract and will incur music fees and the new service requirement as described above;
- does not guarantee a spot on the ice; it can only be used if space is available;
- is to be used by only one skater, just like a contracted session; and
- is valid only for the fall/winter season.

In addition, a skater with a Season Pass will be given the priority for a place on an ice session over a regular walk-on.

Music Volunteer Duties

We wish to remind those considering signing up to play music that volunteer duties are as follows.

Volunteers are needed to take attendance, accept buy-on payments, and be responsible for making the harness available, and play music. The volunteer is expected to enforce the club's rules regarding its ice sessions and walk-on fees.

The music fee will be credited back to your account at the conclusion of the (Fall/Winter) session if you have volunteered **7** times during the session. Volunteers must arrive 10 minutes before the start of their session (at ice make) to begin to accept buy-ons and to relieve the previous monitor. It is imperative that the walk-on fees, music box, attendance box, and harness are locked up if there is no one there to relieve you or if you are the last person playing music for the day. If you are a volunteer during a session for which there is a prior moves session, you are responsible for attendance and buy-ons for the moves session as well. All of your efforts will help PPFSC run more smoothly. We appreciate your cooperation.
