Music Volunteer Duties

We wish to remind those considering signing up to play music that volunteer duties are as follows.

Volunteers are needed to take attendance, accept buy-on payments, and be responsible for making the harness available, and play music. The volunteer is expected to enforce the club's rules regarding its ice sessions and walk-on fees.

The music fee will be credited back to your account at the conclusion of the (Fall/Winter) session if you have volunteered **4** times during the session. Volunteers must arrive 10 minutes before the start of their session (at ice make) to begin to accept buy-ons and to relieve the previous monitor. It is imperative that the walk-on fees, music box, attendance box, and harness are locked up if there is no one there to relieve you or if you are the last person playing music for the day. If you are a volunteer during a session for which there is a prior moves session, you are responsible for attendance and buy-ons for the moves session as well. All of your efforts will help PPFSC run more smoothly. We appreciate your cooperation.
