

Pawtucket & Providence Figure Skating Club Requirements for Professional Privileges

The Pawtucket & Providence Figure Skating Club grants professional privileges to coaches for the purpose of conducting private lessons on Club ice sessions. PPFSC has established two categories of coaching

Full privileges: The coach may teach the approved discipline on any Club session on which the given discipline is allowed. The coach must be age 18 or older.

Restricted privileges: The coach may teach the approved discipline on Fridays only. The coach must be age 16 or older. Any coach under the age of 18 must have a contract signed by a parent/guardian.

In order to qualify, the following test requirements must be met for each category of privileges.

	Test Level Required	
Discipline	<u>Full Privileges</u>	<u>Restricted Privileges</u>
MIF	Novice	Juvenile
Freestyle	Intermediate	Pre-Juvenile
Dance	Silver	Pre Silver

Basic Skills Instructor: An individual must qualify for full privileges in at least one discipline in order to be considered as a Basic Skills Instructor. Basic Skills Instructors are appointed by PPFSC to teach in its Basic Skills Program during ice time designated for this purpose. Coaches who teach in the Basic Skills and /or Bridge Program in PPFSC may teach any of the elements in the Basic Skills curriculum as a private lesson during the session in which Basics/Bridge are taught. On regular Club sessions, coaches may teach only those disciplines for which they have been granted privileges.

As a part of the contract with PPFSC, each coach must provide proof of:

- current USFS Coaches Registration (contains USFS membership, Professional Liability Insurance and Background Check);
- PSA Membership by July 1st (PSA membership year now corresponds to USFS membership year);
- compliance with the USFS Continuing Education Requirements (CER); and
- CPR training/certification.
