Open Combined: All levels MIF/Freestyle/Dance – **No Pairs** (This exclusion does not apply to similar pairs / duets or dance.)

- There will be a \$20 fee added to your bill for each check that is returned to us for insufficient funds.
- Skaters are placed on sessions in the order in which the assistant treasurer receives the applications up until the deadline. Full members are given first consideration, associates next, then non-members. After the deadline, only the postmark is the deciding factor.
- You may not drop a session once it has begun.
- The Board of Governors reserves the right to change the level requirements or discipline of any session that is under-enrolled.

All ***bills must be paid in full*** before the spring application will be accepted. We are looking forward to an enjoyable, productive season ahead.

A music fee of \$25 will be added to the ice bill of a skater who does not play music for 2 sessions during this season. You can avoid this charge by playing music for 2 sessions. Please note that we are not collecting this fee in advance. DO NOT add it to your ice bill, unless you do not want to play music.

Music fee is charged per skater. Volunteer is responsible for fulfilling music obligation for each skater in the family who contracts ice.

The undersigned should understand that:

Should a skater cease skating for any reason (except for a medical condition requiring doctor's care and board approval) after the start of the skating session decide to cancel, he/she will be held responsible for FULL PAYMENT.

Failure to pay your ice bill by the above schedule will result in the skater not being allowed to skate, test, compete or exhibit until payments are made.

Music Volunteer Duties

We wish to remind those considering signing up to play music that volunteer duties are as follows.

Volunteers are needed to take attendance, collect walk-on payments, and play music. The volunteer is expected to enforce the club's rules regarding its ice sessions and walk-on fees.

Volunteers must arrive 10 minutes before the start of their session (at ice make) to begin to collect walk-ons and to relieve the previous monitor. It is imperative that the walk-on fees, music box, attendance book, are locked up if there is no one there to relieve you or if you are the last person playing music for the day. All of your efforts will help PPFSC run more smoothly. We appreciate your cooperation.

You will receive a walk-on pass for each additional two times that you play music/collect fees.

Our spring session will be held on Sundays at 11:00-11:50 a.m. at the Smithfield Municipal Rink. Class will run from May 7-June 25, with no weeks off. There are eight classes in all.

Session fees for skaters who have a current membership with *Learn to Skate USA* are as follows:

- Snowplow Sam \$80
- Basic Badge \$112

These fees would apply to any skaters who have taken lessons with PPFSC at any time since July 2022.

Skaters who do not have a membership will need to obtain one directly with Learn to Skate USA for an additional charge of about \$16. Directions for how to obtain this membership will receive this information once they reply to this email as described below.
