

PPFSC 2020 Summer Ice

PPFSC has reserved ice time at Lynch Arena in Pawtucket for the upcoming summer. The details are as follows.

Day and times: Tuesday evenings, 5:00-5:50, 6:00-6:50, 7:00-7:50

Session dates: July 7-August 25

All sessions are Open Combined. Due to restrictions on the number of skaters on the ice, there will be no Learn to Skate on the Tuesday sessions.

Currently, the maximum number of people allowed on the ice is 15; this includes skaters and coaches. The governor will be announcing new guidelines for sports at the end of this month. It is hoped that there will be an increase in the number allowed on the ice. We plan on sending out contract information by next week.

Unless we are allowed to have our regular numbers on the ice, we will be forced to charge higher prices than usual.

Regardless of the number allowed, PPFSC will follow the policy that it has been stated on our previous ice applications.

Skaters are placed on sessions in the order in which the assistant treasurer receives the applications up until the deadline.* Full members are given first consideration, associates next, then non-members. After the deadline, only the postmark is the deciding factor.

Please note that in order to be placed on any of the summer sessions, skaters must first have a membership for 2020-21 with USFS, either through a club or as an individual. Non-PPFSC members must also have an Associate Membership for 2020-21 in order to be given the priority as stated above.
